

Patrick E. Bell, 23, of Worcester, formerly of Greenfield, MA died Sunday 6/19/05 at the Metro West Medical Center in Framingham shortly after competing in a triathlon in Ashland.

He was born in Northampton, MA on January 21, 1982, the son of William and Paula (Cunningham) Bell. He graduated from Deerfield Academy in 2000 where he was on the varsity cross country team for four years and the varsity swim team and varsity cycling team for two years. He graduated from the University of Massachusetts in Amherst in 2004 with degrees in computer science and computer systems engineering.
